

South Fork Mine

Highway 199 extends between Grants Pass (Interstate 5) in southern Oregon and Crescent City (Highway 101) in northern California.

Take Highway 199 to the small town of Selma and turn onto Deer Creek Road. Travel 9.3 miles up Deer Creek Road until you find where the road splits. This is where the North Fork branches off to the left (north). This claim is located on the South fork (take the road which splits to the right) about ½-mile upstream from this split in the road. Look for where the power lines cross the road. The lower-end of this claim begins about 200 yards upstream from the power lines. There is an old access road which extends to the creek near the lower-end of the claim. The claim extends ¼-mile upstream from that point.
